**SUBJECT:** Moratorium Extension on the Approval of Certification to Provide

**Moderate Sedation** 

The Board has extended the moratorium on the approval of certification to provide moderate sedation to patients 12 years old and under, for dentists who have learned the modality in a short course format (i.e. less than one year). This would be in place for an additional year or until such time as the new criteria for registration of qualifications to provide moderate sedation for pediatric patients have been developed and incorporated in to sedation standards.

This moratorium was approved by the College Board on 24 November 2017 as recommended by Sedation & General Anaesthetic Services Committee.

SUBJECT: Moratorium on the Approval of Certification to Provide Moderate Sedation
